Dr. Yang is involved in several large scale RCT's for gastric cancer treatment. He is Korean PI of REGATTA study (Phase III study for the role of gastrectomy in stage IV gastric cancer with a single incurable factor; a collaborative study between JCOG and KGCA). He is investigator of CLASSIC trial, KLASS trials as well as the Korean PI of a phase II study for the role of neoadjuvant imatinib treatment in large gastric GIST (a collaborative study between Japan and Korea). His translational research interests are Gastric Carcinogenesis, DDS, familial gastric cancer, biomarkers and developing PDX model for gastric cancer.
